On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- (a) the transfers of duties, powers and functions, and other changes, set out in Appendix A to this order are made,
(b) each member of the Executive Council listed in Appendix B is charged with the administration of the enactments specified in Appendix B for that member,
(c) provisions in previous orders are rescinded insofar as these provisions
(i) are inconsistent with a transfer or change made under paragraph (a) of this order, or
(ii) charge another member of the Executive Council with responsibility for the administration of an enactment in a manner that conflicts with paragraph (b) of this order, and
(d) a transfer or change under paragraph (a), or a transfer of administration under paragraph (b), of this order serves also to transfer to the member of the Executive Council the unexpended balance of money and other resources authorized for the administration of the duties, powers, functions and enactments involved.

APPENDIX A

Advanced Education and Labour Market Development

- 1** The duties, powers and functions of the Attorney General and Minister Responsible for Multiculturalism respecting immigration policy and programs, other than the portion of those policies and programs respecting multiculturalism, are transferred to the Minister of Advanced Education and Labour Market Development.

Finance

- 2** The duties, powers and functions of the Minister of Advanced Education and Labour Market Development, the Minister of Education and Minister Responsible for Early Learning and Literacy, the Minister of Health Services and the Minister of Transportation and Infrastructure respecting the management and payment of short and long term debt servicing of approved capital projects referred to in Votes 12, 25, 37 and 43 are transferred to the Minister of Finance.

Forests and Range

- 3** The duties, powers and functions of the Minister of Community Development respecting the Forests for Tomorrow Program are transferred to the Minister of Forests and Range.

Labour and Citizens' Services

- 4** Responsibility for the management and allocation of the Community Development Trust Fund is assigned to the Minister of Labour and Citizens' Services.
- 5** The duties, powers and functions of the Minister of Housing and Social Development and the Minister of Children and Family Development respecting capital construction of the integrated case management information technology system are transferred to the Minister of Labour and Citizens' Services.

Technology, Trade and Economic Development

- 6** The duties, powers and functions of the Minister of Advanced Education and Labour Market Development respecting the Leading Edge Endowment Fund Society and the Premier's Technology Council are transferred to the Minister of Technology, Trade and Economic Development and Minister Responsible for the Asia-Pacific Initiative.
